The two most common types of master's degrees are the Master of Arts (M.A.) and Master of Science (M.Sc.); these may be course-based (Taught MA), research-based (MA by Research and Thesis), or a mixture of the two. Some universities use the Latin degree names; because of the flexibility of word order in Latin, the Master of Arts and Master of Science may be known as magister artium or artium magister and magister scientiæ or scientiarum magister, respectively. 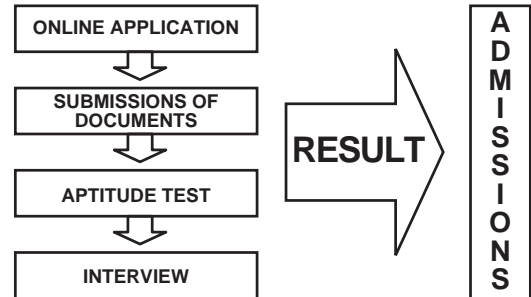
